Application Specifications:

- 1. Seminary scholarships for Members in Discernment
 - Committee on Ministry Section for Discernment (COM D) will review applications together at their next scheduled meeting.
 - The maximum amount per recipient is \$1,000 for a period of one school year.
 - Applicants may request renewal of scholarship from one year to the next.
 - Once approved, disbursement will be made to the recipient upon submission of proof of enrollment from the seminary.
 - Use of funds is not limited to tuition and may be used for fees, books, equipment, living expenses, and other costs associated with their studies.
- 2. Continuing Education for Authorized Ministers
 - Committee on Ministry Section for Authorization (COM A) will review applications together at their next scheduled meeting.
 - The maximum amount per recipient is \$1,000 per year.
 - Disbursement will be made to the recipient.
- 3. Clergy Counseling a wide variety of mental health and discernment support resources are available through our partner, Midwest Ministry Development. Requests for assistance in covering fees for these programs can come through the CM or directly through MMDS, ensuring some level of privacy with regards to the type of support requested. The CM will only be asked to disburse funds (up to \$1500) to an individual, without further details shared. Other mental health support resources can also be accessed through these funds by contacting the CM.

Applicant Qualifications

For scholarships, qualified applicants will be Members in Discernment working with the K-O Conference Committee on Ministry Section D and holding membership in a UCC congregation in Kansas or Oklahoma.

For continuing education and clergy counseling, qualified applicants will be authorized ministers serving in local congregations or specialized ministry and up-to-date with requirements for standing.
